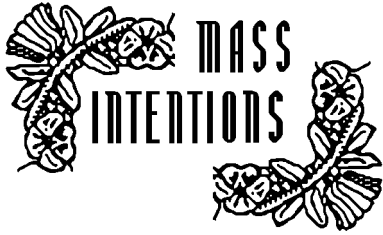
WE'RE GLAD YOU ARE HERE!

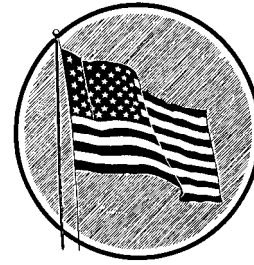
