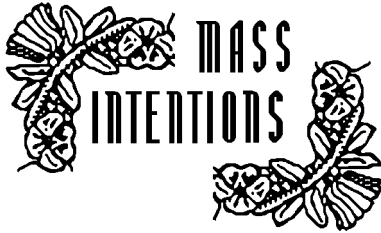
**WE'RE GLAD YOU ARE HERE!**

The Sanctuary Candle burns this week in the Church in Loving Memory of Patrick R. Hurley donated by his Family.

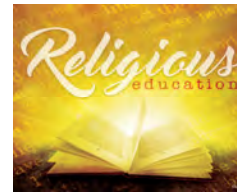


Here we are again thanking all the wonderful parishioners who kindly answered "yes" to our request and baked for the Family Masses.

**Reflections on the 14th Sunday**

**in Ordinary Time**

**Cycle B**

As Americans living in freedom and independence God has blessed us in unique, varied and wonderful ways through families, gifts, talents and other things. Each day we hear of helpless or devastating situations and stories and we must ask ourselves, how being a Catholic makes a difference. Do we hear the words of the prophets? In the gospel of Mark a recurring theme is lack of faith. In light of this can you imagine a difference when people live faith with freedom and independence? Have we ever thought about the difference in our lives?

Notice that Jesus in love for His people does not let lack of faith on the part of His disciples and consequently us be an obstacle in the ultimate way. Jesus shows Himself as the Son of God even to those who wish Him to be a simple carpenter born to Mary and Joseph. Please notice also that lack of faith on the part of the disciples or our part does not lead to a lack of compassion or a lack of forgiveness on the part of Jesus. Do we too undervalue Jesus or anyone else?

As we celebrate the Eucharist this weekend our prayer is that others may share their faith experience with us and we may share our faith experience with them.

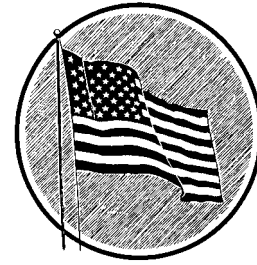

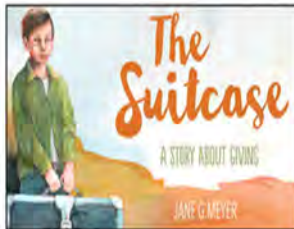
