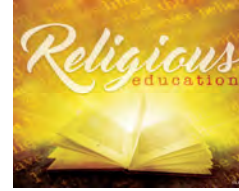
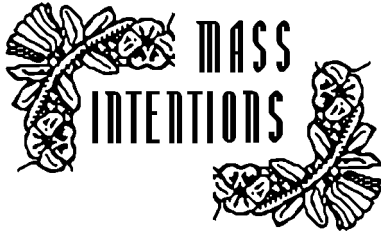
WE'RE GLAD YOU ARE HERE!

REFLECTIONS ON THE 15TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME—CYCLE B

The greatest news that the twelve disciples carried with them wherever they traveled was the good news of Jesus. Jesus knew that the disciples would make mistakes, but at the same time it was time for the disciples to do what Jesus had instructed them to do. The mission that Jesus gave to His disciples and gives to us comes from the Father. He received this mission when He was baptized by John. It is both awesome and humbling to realize that Jesus entrusts His mission to us. God has bestowed upon us a divine favor in Jesus Christ. By our Baptisms we are challenged to be bearers of the Good News and to preach repentance.

This raises some questions for our considerations. When was the last time any of us thought about our Baptism or what this rite says? What does it mean to be a parish community and a collaborative that passes on the Good News of Jesus to others? How do evangelization and social action go hand in hand? How do we help others discover their inner gifts to promote God's Kingdom of love, justice and mercy? Do we let people know what they mean to us and how they reflect God to us? Do we see in our new collaborative new opportunities to share all we have with others?

There are going to be great opportunities ahead to build God's kingdom.
