**HOSPITALITY MEETING**

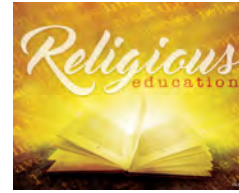
Our next meeting will be **Tuesday, August 7th at 10:00am in the Church Hall.**
