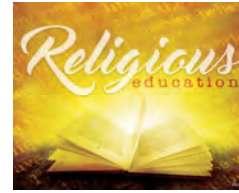

### REFLECTIONS ON THE 17th SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME—CYCLE B

We can learn a big lesson about life from the young person in today's gospel. Jesus and His disciples might have been facing a serious problem; they were facing a hungry tired crowd with no food to feed them. This child offered his own lunch to feed the crowd. We know that this child was poor because in Jesus' day only poor people made bread from barley. This child had only enough food for himself but he was willing and proud of what he could offer. Whatever we can offer Jesus can always turn into so much more.

The miracles and signs of Jesus point to a time when God's mighty deeds come to fulfillment, a time when all people are abundantly filled and every need is met. This miracle of abundance points to the establishment of a new kingdom, a sign of God's lavish love for His people. The people were looking for miracles but were not concerned at the beginning with the message of Jesus. However the people then and now have a deeper hunger than just for food. When people are hungry they are not as likely to be able to have the time to appreciate the message of Jesus. When we share the message of Jesus with others, do we help them with their hungers as well? If Jesus can multiply loaves He can change bread and wine into His Body and Blood. Thank you, Jesus.
