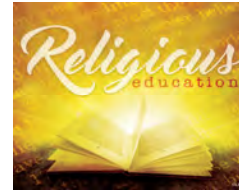

REFLECTIONS ON THE 18th SUNDAY

IN ORDINARY TIME-CYCLE B

What are the things that we long for or hunger for in life? How have hungers been satisfied when people turned to Jesus? What do we look to God for? Jesus is the bread that satisfies all hunger. Jesus shows in today's gospel that he appreciates the physical need that people have to eat. He fed the five thousand people. Jesus shows an amazing ability to bring great things out of what people share with him. When we give of ourselves by the way we use our time, our talents and our treasures Jesus brings so much to others.

Please notice that in the Lord's Prayer there is a petition for Our Father to give us our daily bread. Jesus challenges us to work for food that endures. The food that endures includes the expressions of God's love for all. The food that endures includes God's Holy Words found in Sacred Scripture. Jesus invites us to believe in Him and to come to Him through the Eucharist where the food and the person are one. Jesus is trying to move the crowd at Capernaum from merely the human experience to understand the element of the divine in their lives and this provides the example for all of us as well.

We receive and consume the Eucharist, the Bread of Life, the Bread from heaven so that the mystery of life may draw us to eternal life. The bread that God offers us is the abiding presence of Jesus among us, always ready and willing to lead us to eternal life.
