PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

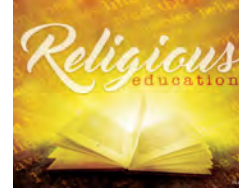
It's that time of the year again. As Fall approaches we are always adding new catechists, choir members liturgical ministers, etc. It is always an exciting and exhilarating time. As volunteers are added, each must first complete the mandates outlined by the Archdiocesan *Policies and Procedures for the Protection of Children*. These mandates include a workshop entitled, *Protecting God's Children* (see dates below). During this training, those new to ministry also submit a CORI (criminal offender record information) and sign a code of conduct. We have scheduled three Protecting God's Workshops spread out over three months. Those dates are:

FORMED THE NETWORK OF THE FIRM

TIPS FOR SIGNING UP FOR FORMED.ORG

What is FORMED.ORG mentioned above? The best way to explain is to say it is like a Catholic Netflix but so much more and is free because of a grant. To date, St. Mary's has 106 parishioners registered on formed.org. To gain access follow these directions:

Enter www.stmaryrandolph.formed.org in the address bar to go to formed.org. Do not use a search bar.

A secure password must be: at least 8 characters, includes letters and numbers, includes at least one special character (for example a punctuation mark like a period, question mark, explanation mark etc.)

If for any reason you have difficulty, there is a second way to register to formed.org. Go directly to the formed.org website. When you click register enter the special code NNZYV. This is the code for the parish of Saint Mary, Randolph. Follow the directions to complete your username (email address) and password.

Don't forget.....there is an app for that. Go to the app store to download formed.org on your cell phones and tablets. Sign in with your username and password. This is available for both IOS users and android users.

FR. PHIL'S INSTALLATION SAVE THE DATE

FAITH FORMATION

During August, Our Religious Education Office is in full steam ahead planning faith formation for the coming year! Yes, this means faith formation for those in kindergarten through grade eleven and Confirmation but so much more! We offer Sacrament prep for ANY age. If you have students who desire First Eucharist and are beyond grade two, we have a plan! If you are an adult who missed receiving First Eucharist and/or Confirmation, we have a plan! If you are an adult who was baptized but never received any other sacraments, we have a plan! If you know someone with a desire to enter the Catholic Church, we have a plan.

Religious Education and Faith Formation here at St. Mary's is more than just classes. Our First Penance and First Eucharist families are treated to a whole community catechesis workshop. Grades 4-6 attend a workshop day on Sacraments that involve parents. During this workshop we spend time learning and role playing Sacraments including celebrating the Eucharist. We have an excellent parish Confirmation Retreat Team made up of many of our parish young adults and results in an amazing intergenerational team of over 30 members! Our middle school and high school students will be leading a social justice project that will involve the whole parish community scheduled for the weekend before Thanksgiving! Our middle school and high school students spend almost 40% of their sessions with speakers, service projects, presentations, movies, prayer, etc. We are gearing up and excited and we hope you are too.

Faith formation for our children and teens is certainly about catechizing them in their Catholic Faith. But it is also so much more! It's a safe place to

enter into with your peers and talk about the day, school, and life. It's hearing from other young people of faith in Jesus Christ. It can be a support group when they have hit a rough spot and an opportunity to lend support to others. It's a place to come to the understanding that we are called to be of service to others. That Christ has no body now but ours. It is learning through videos, movies, music and so much more.

Keep careful watch for our first registration weekend. Come and ask questions if you wish. Share this information with relatives, neighbors and friends. Encourage adults who wish to make Sacraments to come and register, ask questions or call. Don't forget the many resources that can be found on FORMED.org!
